Bible Study Method - TEXTS TBA

Psalms 119:18 Open thou mine eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of thy law.

A. Sharing & Prayer (examples)

- What is something you're thankful for? (Thank God directly in prayer.)
- What is something you I your family I your neighbors are struggling with?
- What is God saying to you through the preaching / your study of the Word of God?
- How can we pray for you to obey what God is showing you through His Word?

B. Group Bible Study: Read the Text.

- Read the text.
- Make sure everyone understands what the text says / means by someone simply paraphrasing / rehearsing the text in their own words. If an important point or nuance is missed, someone else in the group can point it out.
- What is God saying to you through His Word?
 - o Run down any cross references the Holy Spirit prompts.
 - Ask questions (that you have, or perspectives that you'd like to hear from others in the group.)

Remember: This is a "discovery method" in which your group is to study directly from God's Word and where the Holy Spirit reveals God's truth as you study God's Word together. Do not take all the group time to lecture or teach.

If the group / someone gets stuck - just ask questions. You can avoid stealing the Holy Spirit's job by simply pointing people back to the Bible. "What does the text say?'

Goal: for the Holy Spirit teach God Truth to His people through His word. 1 Cor 2:9-14

Fire starters: A few sample questions / things to observe in a passage.

- 1. What does this teach/reveal about God (Father, Jesus, Spirit)?
- 2. What does this reveal about mankind? You personally?
- 3. What does God /Jesus do? (Is there an example from Jesus we can follow?)
- 4. What does God command us to do? (Are there any clear commands to obey?)
- 5. How are you going to obey God's Word to you personally?
- 6. How could we obey this lesson as a group / church?

C. Decision time.

- Share what you learned with others. Who?
- Pray for God to help everyone to obey AND to boldly tell others.
- Determine to simply OBEY what God has shown you through His Word.
- Follow up on decisions others have made for God provide ongoing prayer and loving accountability.
