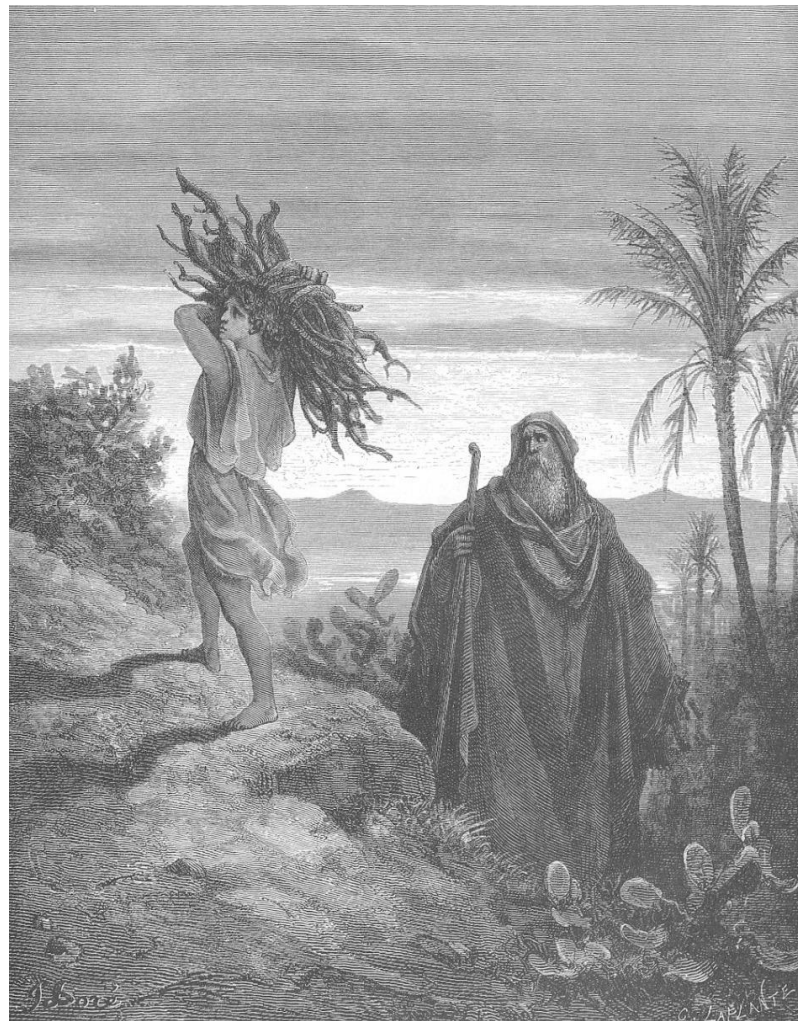

For though he have ten thousand instructors in Christ, yet have ye not many fathers: for in Christ Jesus have I begotten you through the gospel.

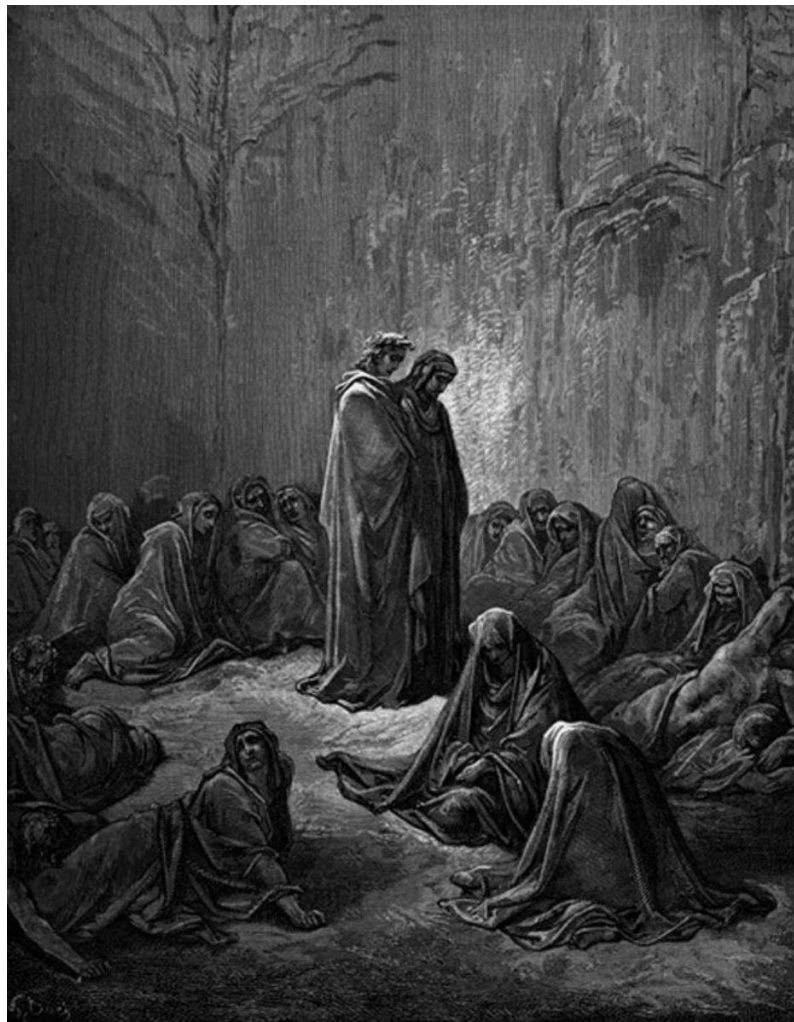


## Key Point 2

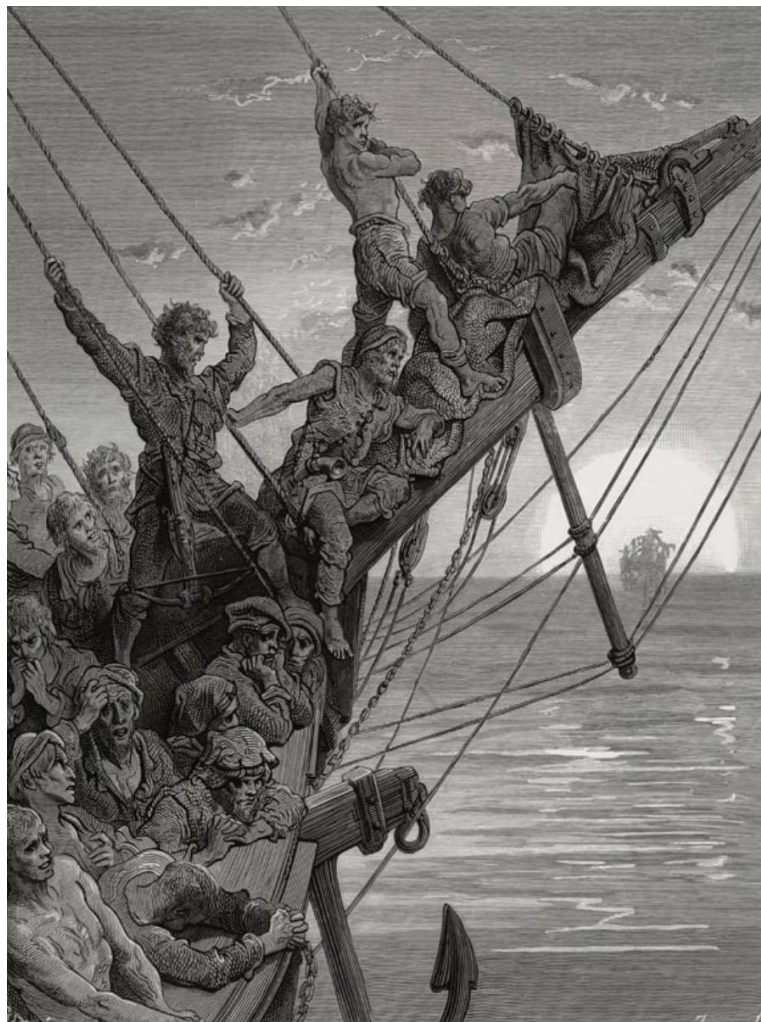
## Key Point 3

gospel



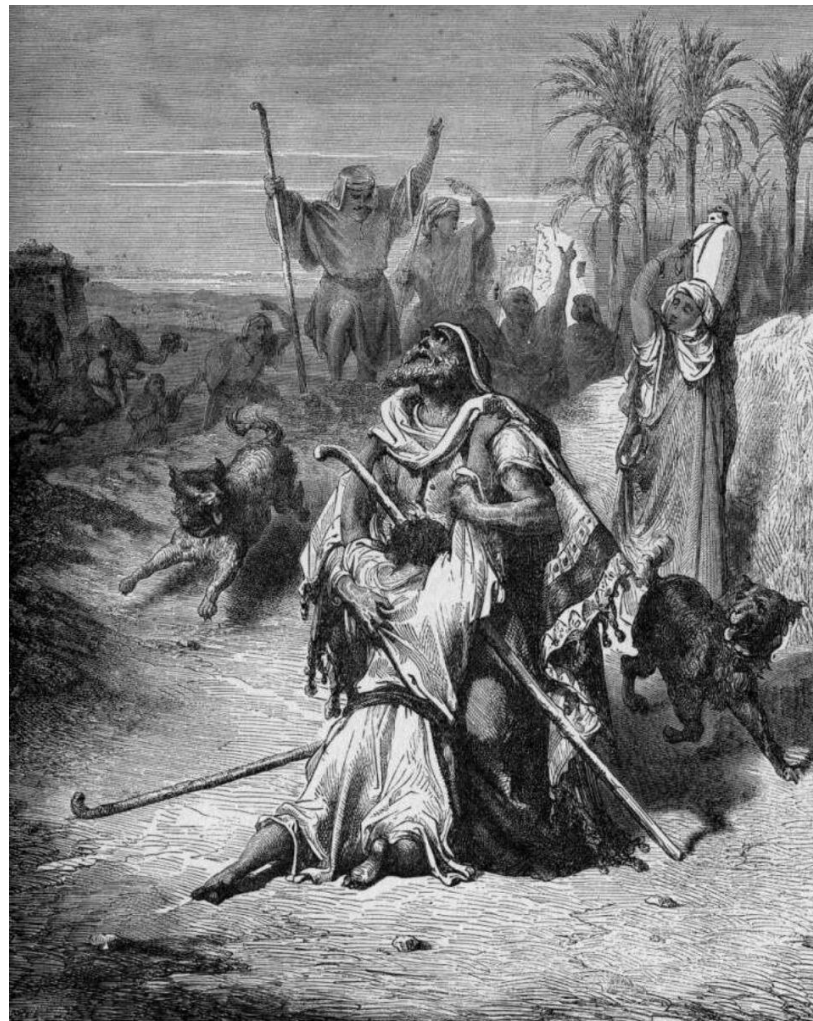
## Mark 1:19-20
