

# Dumping David – 1 Samuel 29

## 1. A massive threat! Vs 1-2

- This story continues from 1 Samuel 28:1-6
- Vs 1: David, the NEXT KING OF ISRAEL, is in a jam!
- KEY: When you hang with \_\_\_\_\_ people, you will have \_\_\_\_\_ in your life.
- Vs 2: He is Achish's, the KING of the Philistines, personal guard. (and 29:2) "Rereward"
- Twice David spared Saul's life, but now he is with those that are the \_\_\_\_\_ of Saul's \_\_\_\_\_. **1 Samuel 26:9-11**
- The lesson in the picture: Living lost will demand that you come \_\_\_\_\_ God's people! **Psalm 26:1-5**
- Beware! **Proverbs 4:14; 24:1; Psalm 1:1; Exodus 23:2a; 34:12; Ephesians 5:11; 2 Thessalonians 3:6; 2 Corinthians 6:14-16**

## 2. A spot-on accusation. Vs 3-5

- "these Hebrews" – ethnic identity. They were on their way to war against Israel. The princes had more sense than their king!
- Vs 3: Achish's \_\_\_\_\_ of David.
- The princes were not \_\_\_\_\_!
- Vs 4: The princes did not understand that David could never be reconciled to Saul. They didn't know Saul's hatred of David was over the fact that David would be the NEXT KING OF ISRAEL!
- The picture: an adversary "a satan" is described as someone who claims to be an ally, but when opportunity arises, will turn and attack! **2 Corinthians 11:13-14**; Example Matt 4. "you need to eat." It's really temptation to rebel against the Father.
- Vs 5: Achish, did you forget?!
- Key lesson in the picture: the world is never really your \_\_\_\_\_!
- You will face rejection for being part of God's family. **John 15:19**
- Our place is WITH GOD'S \_\_\_\_\_. **Ephesians 4:16; Phil 3:20**

## 3. A deluded confidence. Vs 6-11

- Vs 6: Achish confirms his confidence in David in THE LORD'S name!
- Vs 7: Being dumped by the world is a good thing!  
This keeps David from being forced into a situation where he could be tempted to sin against God and His people.  
**1 Corinthians 10:13; Jude 1:24-25**
- What David escapes in this battle... Saul receives in it! **2 Peter 2:9**
- Vs 8: Getting \_\_\_\_\_ still \_\_\_\_\_.
  1. David \_\_\_\_\_.
  2. David \_\_\_\_\_. "let me fight!" and "my Lord the king?" Which one? This again is dissimulation.  
The Philistine lords were right.
- Vs 8: Picture pointing to Christ. \_\_\_\_\_ times Achish \_\_\_\_\_ David! Vs 3,6 and 9. Compare John 18:38; 19:4, 6
- Vs 10: "thy masters" Achish has some small suspicion now?
- Vs 11: When you leave God's people and take refuge with the world, guess what? They don't love you either.
- Outside of God's promises? There is no provision there, only disaster! **1 Samuel 30:1-2**
- Satan is in the business of taking God's people \_\_\_\_\_! **2 Timothy 2:26**
- **Picture:** Not living in the promises of God? That doesn't just damage you. It hurts those that are connected to you!
- Notice the picture! Because Saul didn't obey **1 Samuel 15:2-9** the enemy was able to hurt others.
- **The picture:** \_\_\_\_\_ sin can \_\_\_\_\_ others.

Note: while David was fighting for his family, Saul was fighting for his life. This is the battle where Saul and his son are killed.
