LEADERS! What is your MANNER toward those that you minister to? Part 3 Review: 1 Thess 2:7-8. Paul describes his care of them as one of gentle love.

- Vs 7-8: We lay **down** our lives **loving** those that we **lead** in ministry.
- Growing leaders: Be <u>gentle</u>! Exodus 2:7-9
 Biblically, a "nurse" is someone that raises a child like a <u>MOTHER</u>!
- Key: you cannot <u>effectively</u> minister to those ("nurse those") that you do not <u>love</u>. That only works, when your love is **FACT** not **FAKE**.
