2.	 We must partake of the afflictions of the Gospel in God's power. Vs 8b We have the opportunity, thru God's power, to suffer for the Gospel's sake! Phil 1:28–30 			
	For the Christian, getting saved and going to heaven is only of the joy in Christ. God wants to give his children a life of PURPOSE. But that purpose is in opposition to this world's culture and plan - you WILL be opposed.			
	 KEY: Vs 9 "who hath saved us" That is the prerequisite to the holy calling that we have in Christ. Are you saved?

People need this Gospel message. To get that message out, it necessarily means persecution. Let's endure the hard times. Let's not waste our life on comfort, ease, and self-fulfillment.

Let's be partakers of the afflictions of Christ.
