2 Timothy 2:1 Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus.

1. Wherefore “Thou therefore?”

- Rule in Bible study.

- Paul knows this is the end. **2 Timothy 4:6**

Timothy (like Joshua before him) is to take Paul’s mantle and place. As such he must follow Paul’s example of enduring the sufferings that come with being a partaker of Gospel ministry.

2. You must be strong in grace. How?

- Paul tells Tim that he is to be strong in the GRACE **that is in** Christ Jesus.
- In chapter one we saw 4 things that you have in Christ Jesus on just one page of your Bible. Vs 1: life, vs 9: an holy calling, vs13: faith and love
- Once you have Jesus you have God’s grace.
- How grace works. **Ephesians 2:8-9**
- How faith works. **Romans 10:17**

- Consider all that is before us in 2 Timothy 2!
- How do you use strength? **1 John 2:14** compare **Proverbs 14:4**
- **KEY:** Realize that your strength is of NO VALUE to our Mighty God! You can be the strongest most talented person in the world, but without the hand of God on your life, your strength is of no consequence! **Zechariah 4:6**

Paul was a physically weak man – he had no power in the flesh and that was the key to the secret of strength in his life. **2 Corinthians 12:7-10**
