God gave us His Word as Holy men of old spake under the *inspiration* of the Holy Ghost. **2 Peter 1:20-21**

But He will *impart* His Word to you if you will receive it. **1 Corinthians 2:12-13**

Once you HAVE IT, you must TELL IT! **2 Timothy 4:1-4**

We need to get the message out. **Don't horde a good thing! Example: 2 Kings 7:8-9**

Take Heed to the Charge

"I CHARGE thee!" This isn't something just to *think* about. It is a command.

This is nothing new. Timothy received several "charges" from Paul. **1 Timothy 1:18; 5:21; 6:13-14**

You are responsible to learn and use the Scriptures because God made you a minister.

This charge/command to preach the word is _____ by the Lord Jesus Christ!

One day, you will stand before the SON! Terrible in His glory! **Hebrews 9:27**

- **Our Judge.**

*"the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge **the quick and the dead** at his appearing and his kingdom;"*

Example: Your Bible is _____. **Hebrews 4:12**

Jesus WILL judge the **living** and the **dead**. **Acts 10:42; 1 Peter 4:5**

Example: If you know a test is coming what do you do?

God judged your sin at _____ 2000 years ago. **Romans 5:8-9**

In Jesus' _____ coming, He didn't come to bring judgment upon man. **John 3:17**

God the Father's judgment was already decreed from Genesis 2 to Romans 3:23 - "*all have sinned.*" **Romans 6:23; John 1:29**

All of Adam's race has sinned, so all MUST DIE. Thank God for the second / last Adam!

He alone would be able to take the sin of Adam's race upon Himself and pay anointment for it. **John 7:37-38; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Ephesians 2:1-9**

You must have a heart to help! You need patience and a love for people, and you need doctrine. **1 Timothy 4:6** compare **1 Timothy 4:1–2**

- You are to reprove. **John 3:19-21** How? **Ps 119:105**
 You reprove a brother in Christ by shedding light on a situation, deed, or false teaching!
- You are to rebuke. **Matthew 17:18**; **Mark 8:33**
 Rebuke is the tool that when applied, stops sin in its tracks.
 It provides protection for the individual, and the opportunity for repentance.
- You are to exhort! “*comforted*” Luke 16:25; 2 Corinthians 1:3-4; “beseech” Romans 12:1
