## VS 1: INTRODUCTION

١.	The	Author Greek "Judas" or Hebrew "Judah"
	•	The brother of James and half-brother to Jesus is the identity of the author. <b>Vs 17</b>
		Why not call himself "the brother" of Jesus Christ? He would view himself foremost as a to Jesus.
		At first Jude didn't believe in Jesus. <b>John 7:1-5</b> After the resurrection of Christ, he did. <b>Acts 2:36</b> compare <b>Romans 10:9</b>
		Believers are Christ's servant.  John 12:26; Romans 12:1; Ephesians 6:6–7; Matthew 20:27; Colossians 3:23–24; Psalm 2:11
	•	Jude / Judas, Jesus' half-brother was an apostle. <b>Vs 17</b>
	•	Obviously, the author is not Judas Iscariot. Act 1.
	•	The Jude does work as the author as well. He was another brother of another James Acts 1:11–14; John 14:22; He is called "Thaddaeus" in Mark 3:16–19; Matthew 10:1-4; Luke 6:13-16. He is also an excellent option for authorship.
	•	Either way, Jude was 1 Corinthians 9:5
	•	He was a servant of <b>Jesus Christ</b> . <i>Note the name order</i> .  Jesus Christ = "Jesus the Messiah"
		<u>Jesus</u> is His name for! "Jehovah Saves" OR "The Lord delivers."
		Jesus means! Matthew 1:20–21
		<u>Christ</u> = "Anointed" Anointed One. Christ is the name for His position and place as the promised Messiah.
2.	The	Recipients. Vs 1b Sanctified. Holy. "To make holy" That is our standing in Jesus Christ. It means we are set apart to God the Father thru Jesus. It is the relationship we now have with God the Father thru the sacrifice of His Son.

	•	Preserved (Secured!) 2 Corinthians 5:21; Philippians 1:6
		The same word is "keep" "kept" and "reserved" in vs 6, 13, 21. <b>John 17:12</b>
		Contrast Judas Iscariot the betrayer who was not kept. He stands in contrast to every other believer in Jesus Christ

Notice that we are preserved <u>IN</u> Him! Romans 8:1; 2 Corinthians 5:17 O.T. picture: Noah's ark.
