	 Over and over the admonition is to do a self-examination. The warning: "Take the mark of the beast and be cut of from God."
	 Jude's commands will directly apply during "the time of Jacob's trouble." Jeremiah 30:7; 31:7; Romans 9:27; 11:25–27
	What about the church age believer?
	Of all the General Epistles, John has the most to say that applies to us in the church age . 1 John 5:4–5
	AGAIN: In the age of GRACE, you don't keep yourself in the love of God, HE KEEPS YOU! Romans 8:38–39 compare John 10:27–30

• Once you have the love of God (John 14:21; 15:4) nothing can separate the church age believer from the love of God, but you can have bitterness or defilement keep you from enjoying it (as close to "cut off" as the believer can get.
