### PRESENTING!

#### A Wonderful Doxology

1. Our great Saviour – our GLORIOUS \_\_\_\_\_! Vs 24a
  - Never fall? HOW?

#### Jesus is \_\_\_\_\_! Romans 14:4

- To give in need. 2 Chron 25:9
  - To deliver! Dan 3:17
  - To abase the proud. Dan 4:37
  - To raise up children unto Abraham of stones. Matt 3:9; Luke 3:8
  - To destroy both soul and body in hell. Matt 10:28
  - To graft Israel in again. Rom 11:23
  - To make the believer stand. Rom 14:4
  - To make all grace abound. 2 Cor 9:8
  - To do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think. Eph 3:20
  - To subdue all things unto himself. Phil 3:21
  - To keep that which I have committed unto him. 2 Tim 1:12
  - To succour them that are tempted. Heb 2:18
  - To save! Heb 7:25
  - To save and to destroy. James 4:12
- The word “keep” – to guard, watch, NOT TO SLEEP. God watches for His own.

#### At salvation, He’s \_\_\_\_\_ YOU! John 10:29-30

The bible teaches the eternal security of the believer.

**Jude 21; John 3:16; 1 John 1:2, 25; 5:9-21**

#### How? Col 2; Rom 6-8; 2 Cor 5:17; John 3:3; 1 John 3:1

The believer is born into the family / the life of God Himself!

- Tribulation context consideration for “Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling”  
God is able to give dying grace – to not take the mark of the beast. **Rev 13-14.**

#### Thru sanctification, He’s made a \_\_\_\_\_ FOR YOU! 1 Cor 10:1–13; 2 Cor 10:3–6

**Example. Numbers 21:4–9**

Somebody might say today, “If God is so powerful, why doesn’t God kill the devil?” God doesn’t kill the devil. He puts His Son, the Lord Jesus, on a cross.

You see, Christianity, *my dear friend*, is not the \_\_\_\_\_ of problems from life. It is the \_\_\_\_\_ of power to meet those problems. And God has a way for you, and God will make a way for you.<sup>3</sup>

#### Hallelujah! Jesus is ABLE! Ephesians 3:20

**KEY:** Jesus is \_\_\_\_\_! So He works to present us the \_\_\_\_\_! Vs 24b;

#### Romans 8:29

- Faultless? HOW?

When we meet Jesus we are to be presented to Him, FAULTLESS!

In the OT the sacrifice had to be FAULTLESS. Without spot or blemish.

So also Christ, so also His people. **2 Corinthians 11:2; Ephesians 5:27; Colossians 1:22, 28**

Whatever is left to accomplish in this work of proper presentation, Jesus finishes it at the rapture of the church. **1 Corinthians 15:52; Philippians 1:6**

Why? **Romans 8:38–39**

To “see” God’s work in us is such an encouragement to us!  
**Ephesians 1:18–20; 1 Peter 4:13; 2 Corinthians 4:17**

NOTE: Even with the transitional context here in Jude – note the progression.

- Salvation. Vs 21
  - Sanctification. Vs 24
  - Glorification. Vs 24-25
2. Our great Saviour – Our God of great \_\_\_\_\_! Vs 25

- He is WISE.  
**Colossians 2:3; Matthew 13:54–57**

John 1:1-4 – He is the God of Creation. **Psalm 104:24**

**KEY:** Wisdom is far more \_\_\_\_\_ than knowledge.

You can know much and still make \_\_\_\_\_ decisions.

Jesus knows everything, AND He always know just \_\_\_\_\_ to do. He never went wrong, messed up, or made a mistake. He is the only wise God. **Psalm 147:5; Romans 11:33**

- He is Saviour. He redeemed us from sin / curse. **2 Corinthians 5:21; 1 Peter 2:24**
- He is our blessed hope! **Titus 2:13**
- To Him be glory!  
 Glory – “doxa” this is the \_\_\_\_\_. The \_\_\_\_\_. Such a fitting end! GLORY!

In these last days, the false teachers are attempting to overturn Christ’s \_\_\_\_\_.  
 Nope. **Revelation 5:12** compare **Ephesians 1:19–23; Hebrews 2:7-8**
