2. Parallel #2: The Angels that sinned. Vs 6

- They are called "wandering stars" in vs 13.
- They are those that followed Lucifer in his rebellion against God.

Angelic beings associated with the fall of Lucifer shared in his principality over the planet Earth—for Satan appears to have taken an early interest in our planet. Some scholars think that the chaotic conditions described in Genesis 1:2 resulted from satanic activity: "The earth was [became] without form and void." The Hebrew is tohu va bohu. The earth was not created tohu (Isa 45:18) but became tohu (Gen 1:2; 2 Pet 3:5–6). In the Fall, Satan wrested from Adam his principality over the earth. That lordship, sovereignty, and headship was Adam's by right of creation (Gen. 1:26; Heb. 2:6-8). Once he had seized Adam's sovereignty over this planet, Satan placed his own angel princes over the various developing nations of the earth. Those angelic princes rule over their respective nations from the spirit world (Dan. 10:12-13, 20-21). It is against these angel powers that we wrestle when we pray (Eph. 6:11-13). The Lord, as the Second Man, overcame them at Calvary (Col. 2:15). He did for us in fact what Boaz did for Ruth in type—redeemed both our persons and our property. These angel principalities of Satan, however, remain active over human affairs in the heavenlies and will continue to do so to the end, when they will be deposed by Michael and his angels (Rev. 12:7–12).

Enoch chapter 15 ^{15.1} And He answered and said to me, and I heard His voice: 'Fear not, Enoch, thou righteous man and scribe of righteousness: approach hither and hear my voice. ² And go, say to the Watchers of heaven, who have sent thee to intercede for them: "You should intercede for men, and not men for you: ³ Wherefore have ye left the high, holy, and eternal heaven, and lain with women, and defiled yourselves with the daughters of men and taken to yourselves wives, and done like the children of earth, and begotten giants as your sons. ⁴ And though ye were holy, spiritual, living the eternal life, you have defiled yourselves with the blood of women, and have begotten children with the blood of flesh, and, as the children of men, have lusted after flesh and blood as those also do who die and perish. ⁵Therefore have I given them wives also that they might impregnate them, and beget children by them, that thus nothing might be wanting to them on earth. ⁶ But you were formerly spiritual, living the eternal life, and immortal for all generations of the world. ⁷ And therefore I have not appointed wives for you; for as for the spiritual ones of the heaven, in heaven is their dwelling. ⁸ And now, the giants, who are produced from the spirits and flesh, shall be called evil spirits upon the earth, and on the earth shall be their dwelling. ⁹ Evil spirits have proceeded from their bodies; because they are born from men, and from the holy Watchers is their beginning and primal origin; they shall be evil spirits on earth, and evil spirits shall they be called. ¹⁰ As for the spirits of heaven, in heaven shall be their dwelling, but as for the spirits of the earth which were born upon the earth, on the earth shall be their dwelling. ¹¹ And the spirits of the giants **afflict**, oppress, destroy, attack, do battle, and work destruction on the earth, and cause trouble: they take no food, but nevertheless hunger and thirst, and cause offences. ¹² And these spirits shall rise up against the children of men and against the women, because they have proceeded from them.'

This was a case of Angels rebelling against God so they could get lascivious in pursuing sexual sin — we know this from the xrefs, but also by the next verse! **Vs 7**They went after strange flesh — vs 7 is the proof text example of Sodom and Gomorrha. If it does not show that, then studying the Bible by comparing Scripture with Scripture is pointless if nothing really means what it says!
