

VS 5-8: WARNING: THE POTENTIAL FOR FALLEN HABITATION

REVIEW: False belief is dangerous in that it leads to rebellion against God. Vs 3-4

To illustrate: Jude draws **three** parallels to verses 3-4.

1. **Parallel #1: The generation of Israel that was delivered from captivity. Vs 5**
ISSUE: Their WORKS.
2. **Parallel #2: The Angels that sinned. Vs 6**
 - Peter's account parallels false teachers with rebellion in the angelic ranks. **2 Peter 2:1-5**
 - Both Jude and Peter are making sure you see apostates/false teachers in the same light as the rebellious angels. **Genesis 6; Matthew 22:29-30**
3. **Parallel #3: The sexual _____ of Sodom and Gomorrah. Vs 7**
 - The Angel's sin and punishment parallel the sin and punishment of Sodom and Gomorrah – Gen 6. Note their damnation. **Vs 7.**
Genesis 19 shows what God thinks about sexual sin.

How does a wrecked family get to such a place?

Lot moved his family to a place where wickedness was practiced openly. **Genesis 13:13**

They hated what was good. So, they purposely rebelled against God.

Genesis 19:1 shows that Lot ends up being a leader in Sodom.

Lot in living _____ Sodom did great damage _____ him! 2 Peter 2:7-8

"filthy" = lustful, sexual excess.

Vine's Words: Filthiness, Filthy, Lascivious, Lasciviousness, Wantonness, Wanton, Wantonly

Psa. 14:3, 53:3; Zeph. 3:1; Rev. 22:11; Col. 3:8

Remember Jude's premise (Vs 3-4) False belief is dangerous in that it leads to rebellion against God. Jude is showing us that apostasy and sodomy are twins.

Result? A defiled Mind: Romans 1. An "Alternate lifestyle" is not approved by God.

The warning! God does give people over to _____ thinking and _____ living!

You cannot miss that there is God, and that you can know Him and his intent.

In order to overthrow God's order, you must DENY Him.

Rebellious man must ignore the testimony of creation in order to make the unnatural and unclean their normal.

The danger! Romans 1:24-32 Now the _____ is their new _____!

Rebellion over false belief makes it so that you CANNOT EVEN THINK CORRECTLY.

Compare **Ephesians 4:19; 1 Corinthians 6:9; Ephesians 5:3; 1 Thessalonians 4:3**

God gives people over; but for that to happen, they must willfully cross over an unnatural threshold. This is translated as "delivered" in **2 Peter 2:4**

Jude is showing us that apostasy and sodomy are _____.

In the last days before Christ's return, rebellion against God proliferates exponentially. We see it clearly today. **2 Peter 3:1-14**

A defiled flesh: Jude 1:8 compare Proverbs 19:3

Prophecy point: Jesus said, as it was in the days of Noah, it will be the same in His 2nd coming.
Luke 17:26–30

What does that look like today?

- Abortion = “choice”
- LGBTQ+ agenda = “alternative lifestyle”
- Gender confusion = Destroying the seed.

6. They commit sin in maintaining error in religion (Jude 1:11; Gen. 4).
7. They serve in religion for gain (Jude 1:11; 2Pet. 2:15; Num. 31:8, 16).
8. They rebel like Korah (Jude 1:11; Num. 16).
9. They practice hypocrisy (Jude 1:12).
10. They commit ungodly deeds (Jude 1:15; Rom. 1).

13. They brag and boast (Jude 1:16).
14. They live in ungodly lusts (Jude 1:4, 16, 18).
