

**REVIEW: False belief is dangerous in that it leads to rebellion against God. Vs 3-4**

To illustrate: Jude draws three parallels to verses 3-4.

1. **Parallel #1: The generation of Israel that was delivered from captivity. Vs 5**
2. **Parallel #2: The Angels that sinned. Vs 6**
3. **Parallel #3: The sexual perversion of Sodom and Gomorrah.**

## VS 8-13: THE PROBLEM WITH RAILING ACCUSATION

### 1. Filthy \_\_\_\_\_. Vs 8

Reprobate minds. They can no longer think in a \_\_\_\_\_ way. **Matthew 9:4; 15:19**

Example: **Ezekiel 8:12, 17-18**

How do you \_\_\_\_\_ a filthy dreamer?

**THEY...**

- Defile the flesh.  
*Typical example: 1 Corinthians 6:15-20*

**KEY:** For the believer, the \_\_\_\_\_ of their body as God's \_\_\_\_\_ must be protected.  
How then can a believer be sexually fulfilled?

\_\_\_\_\_ is God's plan. \_\_\_\_\_ must become \_\_\_\_\_ before God.

**Genesis 2:18; 22-25**

Satan hates God's plan and picture (Christ and His bride) of marriage so, he promotes adultery.

**2 Timothy 3:1-7**

- Despise dominion.  
"despise" = *to reject, to displace, to disregard*  
This rebellion originally started with Satan in his slander of God in working to get Adam and Eve to come out from under God's authority. **Genesis 3:5**  
Those that follow after Satan also despise God's dominion over their lives. **Psalm 2:1-6; 12:4**  
Contrast **Hebrews 13:17**
- Speak evil of dignities.  
Despising dominion, speaking evil of rulers and principalities – This is a great \_\_\_\_\_ to God.  
The \_\_\_\_\_ of God's design must be recognized! **Exodus 22:28; Ecclesiastes 10:20; Acts 23:1-5**  
Example: **Luke 23:39-43**

### 2. Faithful \_\_\_\_\_. Example: Micheal vs Satan. Vs 9

- **The body of Moses:** What is happening here? **Deuteronomy 3:23-27; 34:1-6**  
God sent Michael later to fetch the corpse. Why? **Revelation 11:3-7**

Did Satan want the body of Israel's deliverer? Why? **2 Thessalonians 2:4**

Michael's response? "**The Lord rebuke thee.**"

Why did Micheal respond in this manner? Satan is a principality. **Ephesians 6:12; Colossians 1:16**  
*Before Jesus' incarnation, Jesus models this principle! Zechariah 3:1-2*

Jesus HIMSELF did not rail against Satan! **Matthew 4, Luke 4.** He used the Word of God to set Satan straight.

The good news regarding all thrones, dominions, principalities! **Colossians 1:16**  
 Micheal does get his day. **Revelation 12:7–9**

*The cherry on top of the booty kicking sundae?* **Revelation 20:1–3**

- **Filthy dreamers speak wickedly. Vs 10**

The wicked cannot even \_\_\_\_\_ right, so, they do not \_\_\_\_\_ right.

**John 3:19; Isaiah 5:20**

Why? **Ephesians 4:18; Jeremiah 4:22**

4. **Fool's \_\_\_\_\_: Warning of error. Vs 11**

- **Cain.**

What was "the way of Cain?"

\_\_\_\_\_ over the offering. His improper offering was rejected by God. Able's was not.

\_\_\_\_\_ and then \_\_\_\_\_. **Genesis 4; 1 John 3:12–13**

- **Balaam.**

What was "the error of Balaam?" **Numbers 22-25** compare **Revelation 2:12–14**

Balaam obviously advised Balak on how to get Israel to corrupt \_\_\_\_\_ before God – and have God Himself bring them low.

He found a way to \_\_\_\_\_ Israel without \_\_\_\_\_ them. **2 Peter 2:10–19**

- **Core.**

What was "the gainsaying of Core?" **Numbers 16**

Korah was the man who led a rebellion against the \_\_\_\_\_ of Moses and Aaron.

He wanted to be the man (in Moses' place), so he ran his mouth against God's man, Moses.

Here's the problem. God **put** Moses and Aaron in their positions.

**Deuteronomy 33:4–5; Hebrews 13:7, 17**

God destroyed him, his gang and all that belonged to them.
