## REVIEW: False belief is dangerous in that it leads to rebellion against God. Vs 3-4

To illustrate: Jude draws <u>three</u> parallels to verses 3-4.

- 1. Parallel #1: The generation of Israel that was delivered from captivity. Vs 5
- 2. Parallel #2: The Angels that sinned. Vs 6
- 3. Parallel #3: The sexual perversion of Sodom and Gomorrah. Vs 7-8

## Fool's <u>destruction</u>: Warning of error. Vs 11

- Way of Cain envy, murder and lying.
- Error of Balaam teaching wrong to trip people up and get paid. (Like the Word of Faith cult)
- Gainsaying of Core preaching so as to promote self vs submission to God's structure. Strive Division.

## Five Pictures of Apostates.

1. \_\_\_\_\_. Apostates are brazenly \_\_\_\_\_. Vs 12

- Early Believers had regular times where they met for a meal together. They were called love feasts or "Agape Feasts."
- \_\_\_\_\_around food has always been a very significant thing.
  BUT, to sit at table with someone all with the aim of making merchandise of them was horrid.
  It is the worst kind of betrayal. Apostates come in like they are with us, but really they are only with themselves fulfilling their own mission. Romans 3:13
- Notice that these \_\_\_\_\_are "with you."

The mixed multitude is always a \_\_\_\_\_\_ for any people of faith. Numbers 11:1–6

Example: The Trojan Horse. Titus 1:16

"feeding themselves without fear"

**Remember**: they are eating at a love feat. They are pigging out, while others go hungry. There was a similar problem in Corinth! **1 Corinthians 11:17-34** 

I do wonder, when I look at the text, that these people should feed themselves without fear. I suppose this may allude to the love feasts, but also to the Lord's Supper. How an ungodly man can drink the wine that typifies the blood of Christ when he is all the while crucifying Christ, I cannot understand. How he can break bread at the Lord's Table when he is spending his life with harlots, or gaining money by dishonesty, I cannot comprehend. But sin is an incomprehensible thing.

Some of the best Christians who come to the Lord's Table come there in great fear and trembling, and I have known some, who have had an undoubted right to be there, half afraid to come. Yet those very persons who have a holy fear lest they should come amiss are those who really ought to come. – Charles Spurgeon

- 2. \_\_\_\_\_. Apostates are in reality \_\_\_\_\_. Vs 12b
  - They come with the *promise* of help / life. (They look like ministers of Christ!) In *reality*, they fail to deliver! No life. (They are frauds!)
- 3. \_\_\_\_\_. Apostates are spiritually \_\_\_\_\_! Vs 12c
  - No life! What they do produce ROTS.
  - **RED FLAG:** If everyone you disciple ends up misfiring / divisive / contentious. That's fruit of you, tree! Some trees, you water, you feed, you work for NOTHING in return! **Matthew 7:15–21; 15:13**

- \_\_\_\_\_. Apostates are terribly \_\_\_\_\_\_. Vs 13
- Here: They will overturn you. The waves of the sea are a POWERFUL force.
- An apostate's teaching is damaging. They are brazen in their rebellion. They foam out their shame! Beware! Philippians 3:19; Romans 2:21; Proverbs 11:2
- These apostates, in their pride, look like they are right (they are so confident!) They seem powerful, invincible! But rest assured, they will be shown shameful. Example **1 Timothy 1:18–20**
- *Solution?* 2 Corinthians 4:2

- 5. \_\_\_\_\_. Apostates are eternally \_\_\_\_\_. Vs 13b
  - Stars can equate to Angels. (Described in Job and pictured 1 Cor 15:40-41)
  - Physical stars were created by God. Genesis 1:16 Their purpose Genesis 1:14
  - **KEY:** Stars used to be THE way to \_\_\_\_\_. Any star without a \_\_\_\_\_ course cannot be trusted to navigate!
