

The Point of Praise.

Review:

- **Worship:** Typical rendering of “worship”
 - H7812 - to *depress*, i.e. *prostrate* - bow (self) down, crouch, fall down (flat), humbly beseech, do (make) obeisance, do reverence, make to stoop, worship.
 - G4352 - (meaning to *kiss*, like a dog *licking* his master’s hand); to *fawn* or *crouch to*, i.e. (literal or figurative) *prostrate* oneself in homage (*do reverence to, adore*)
 - In **Acts 19:35** “worshipper” is a “*temple keeper*” or “*temple sweeper*.”
- God chose us to be a people of praise. **1 Peter 2:9-12; John 4:23-24**
- The believer’s capacity for praise in the midst of a great trial.
Paul and Silas in prison. **Acts 16**.
Abraham – the price of worship. His “*only son!*” **Genesis 22:2-14**

1. Why did God make us to be a people of praise? **Ephesians 5:16-20**

- These are evil days. See why. **2 Corinthians 4:4** compare **1 Peter 2:9-12**
 We must be wise! **Vs 17-18**

Praise takes two _____:

ONE: Testimony – or speaking of what God has done in your life.

TWO: Song – in singing the praises of God.

- **Praise flows two _____:**

ONE: To God! (vertical)

TWO: to the multitudes! (horizontal) Consider **Romans 15:7-11**

- **KEY:** It is thru our praise of God, that this ministry will move forward to the GLORY of God.

KEY: Worship done _____ warps our _____ of God.

That in turn further _____ our worship!
